Alternatively, students who secure 75% marks (7.5 CGPA) and above upto 6th semester and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year and they will receive a Bachelor's Degree (Honours with Research) in their Field of Study/Discipline if they choose Research Ethics and Methodology (REM) and Dissertation (DIS) courses in the 7th and 8th semesters, respectively, after earning the required 160 credits upon completing the 8th semester
