Upon completion of the 4th semester, students who opt to exit the program will be eligible for an **Undergraduate Diploma** in their respective Field of Study/Discipline, subject to fulfilling the **requisite 80 credits** and supplementing their academic credits with an **additional 4 credits** earned through skill-based vocational courses offered during the summer term of their 1st or 2nd year, or through a recognized internship/apprenticeship.

Upon successful completion of **Four** years, students will be awarded a **Bachelor's Degree** (**Honours**) in their Field of Study/Discipline if they opt for Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) courses in the 7th and 8th semesters. Alternatively, students who secure 75% marks (7.5 CGPA) and **above upto 6th** semester and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year and they will receive a **Bachelor's Degree** (**Honours with Research**) in their Field of Study/Discipline if they choose Research Ethics and Methodology (REM) and Dissertation (DIS) courses in the 7th and 8th semesters, respectively, after earning the **required 160 credits** upon completing the 8th semester

Upon successful completion of the program, students will be conferred a **Five-Year Integrated Masters Degree** in their respective Field of Study/Discipline, subject to securing the **requisite 200 credits**, which is to be achieved through completion of Ten semesters (Five years) of academic study or **Masters Degree** in their respective Field of Study/Discipline who joins the programme in 9<sup>th</sup> Semester after completion of Four Year Bacholors Degree in the respective Field of Study/ Disciplines and earns the **requisite 40 credits** after successful completion of 9th and 10th Semester.
